

Celebrating Advent: O Come, O Branch of Jesse



This year's advent theme takes its name from Isaiah 11. The prophet speaks of new life emerging from a stump as a sign of new life and new beginnings. A shoot or a branch emerging from a tree stump is a sign of new life and new beginnings. We will celebrate the season by erecting and adorning a "Jesse Tree," which is an advent tradition that began in medieval times.

The Jesse Tree uses symbols to represent Bible stories telling of God's activity in the world from creation through the birth of Jesus. These symbols were an important way of aiding the faithful, most of whom were illiterate, in learning how God, from the very beginning, has promised to be faithful to his people.

The Jesse Tree gets its name from the father of King David. It is based upon this passage in the 11th chapter of the prophet Isaiah:

A shoot shall come out from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots.

The spirit of the LORD shall rest on him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD.

His delight shall be in the fear of the LORD.

He shall not judge by what his eyes see, or decide by what his ears hear;

but with righteousness he shall judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth;

he shall strike the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips he shall kill the wicked.

Righteousness shall be the belt around his waist, and faithfulness the belt around his loins.

Isaiah 11:1-5 NRSV

Jesus was a descendant of King David and Christians understand that Jesus is this new branch or shoot. You may think of the Jesse Tree as a way of telling stories about Jesus' own family tree. Since you were grafted into Christ's family in Holy Baptism, the Jesse tree stories are YOUR stories, too. A symbol for each story will be placed upon the tree after it is told.

Kits for use at home will be provided. There will be ornaments, corresponding Bible verses, and devotional material for each day of the season. They will be available beginning the First Saturday/Sunday of Advent, November 30/December 1. On the weekends of December 1, 8, and 22, we'll review the stories of the Tree in worship.



Finance Update

As we approach the end of another year we are grateful to all our members and friends who have supported St. Luke's with their weekly, monthly and annual gifts. In March 2018 we began our second three-year debt reduction campaign with a goal of raising \$750,000. As we look ahead to December 31, 2019, we expect to receive approximately \$440,000 from 180 giving units who made a formal pledge and another 55 giving units not making a formal pledge. This keeps us close to our goal with only 15 months until the end of this campaign.

Earlier this year our 2019 spending plan was approved and included an 8% increase to provide for the call of an associate pastor. As we approach the end of the year, we are still experiencing a **significant deficit** which we hope and pray can be made up with year-end "catch-up giving" to our General Fund. While we are very thankful for the debt reduction contributions, both pledged and non-pledged, it is also important that we continue to support our General Operating fund which provides funding for all our programs and staffing expenses.

We have just completed a wonderful and dynamic stewardship program, "The Inside Out Church," and learned a new word "kenosis" which means to empty one's self or to pour ourselves out for others. Temple talks and sermon messages centered on being a generous giver as well as growing in giving. We were encouraged to give generously, give proportionally, give of ourselves, our time, our talents, and to engage in ministries. Thank you to the members who delivered their pledge cards for 2020.

We look ahead to 2020 with our new associate pastor joining us and a renewed interest in stewardship as we connect with our community and serve in powerful ways.

2019 Income Tax Deductions: According to IRS regulations, all contributions for the 2019 tax year must be in the church office or offering plate by the end of the 10:00am worship service on Sunday, December 29, 2019 or mailed in a letter postmarked on or before December 31, 2019. The church office will be open on December 30-31, 2019.

Important Tax Notice: To ensure the deductibility of your church contributions, do not file your 2019 income tax return until you have received a written acknowledgment of your contributions from the church. Some of your contributions may not be tax-deductible if you file your tax return before receiving a written acknowledgement of your contributions from the church.

- Keep your eyes open in the coming weeks for the placement of our new Giving Kiosk – convenience and technology – another way to share our offerings and gratitude for the difference God can make in the lives of many. Also, note the QR code in the bulletin. It can be scanned with your phone and offerings made through a credit card or other electronic payment system. Thank you to the Stewardship Team and the Finance Committee for their work in making these technologies available.
- It is exciting to share that our outdated, obsolete phone system is in the process of being replaced! By mid to late December, everything should be upgraded and ready to go, improving the ease of communication and accessibility throughout the building, including not only staff offices but a phone in every Child Life Ministries classroom for added safety, security and convenience. New cabling is now in place. A great deal of time, research and planning went into the decision and the implementation. We truly appreciate all that has been done by the Facilities and Maintenance Team.
- All are welcome to attend the Child Life Ministries Preschool Christmas program on Tuesday, December 17th at 6:30 pm. We're confident you will love it. CLM also has an open house on Tuesday, December 10th from 6 to 7:30 pm. If you know of a family that may be interested in child care, invite them to attend.

Next Steps for Our Partnership



Our guests from Tanzania, Pastor Nathan Makenge and Baraka Melitha, share a sincere thank you to all who helped to pay their travel expenses to allow them to visit us in October! We met and discussed the Next Steps for our Partnership.

1. Continue to pray for relief from the drought due to climate change because it impacts 80% of their members who are farmers.
2. Please continue to support education for it is the way out of poverty and the path to independence for the children.
3. The Penuel congregation would like to set up a primary school for “the babies” under 5 years old and run it at the church like we run the Child Life Ministries program at St. Luke’s. It will be called the Maranatha Nursery and English will be taught to the little ones. This will be a diocese project, and the Bishop has been informed about the planning. Baraka has sent estimates and would like to begin the nursery school for about 50 students in January with our support.
4. We will be informed as soon as the electricity is connected for the milling machine to begin.


Classes follow the school year calendar and the following options will be available for fall 2020:

2 Years Old (by 9/1/20): First Steps to Preschool – Classes meet 1 morning a week - 9:00 to 11:00am (child must be accompanied by an adult).

3 Years Old (by 9/1/20): Classes meet 2 mornings a week - 9:00am to 12:00pm.

4 Years Old (by 9/1/20): Classes meet 2 or 3 mornings a week - 9:00am to 12:00pm. Many families choose to attend our Preschool in the morning and our School District of Waukesha 4K in the afternoon!
