THE FINE PRINT ENROLLMENT IN AND PAYMENT OF YOUR DEPOSIT FOR THE TOUR, CONSTITUTES YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONDITIONS AND STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY.

INCLUDED IN PRICE:

- 1) Round trip airfare per brochure deluxe motor coaches First Class / Superior First Class hotels guided sightseeing entrance fees to sites visited breakfast & dinner daily per brochure
- 2) Taxes and fuel charges totaling **\$678** USD comprised of **\$347.60** for fuel charges (subject to increase by airline up to 30 days prior to departure) and **\$330.40** for taxes (including federal inspection fees for the U.S. Customs and Immigrations; international air transportation tax; agricultural tax; other per person taxes imposed by government entities; airport taxes and fees including the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and U.S. and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person).
- 3) Gratuities of **\$200** for tour guide or cruise director, local host, driver, local guides, and/or ships' crew; gratuities on ferries, and cruise ships.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:

Not included in your package are passports, visas, vaccinations, laundry, lunches, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, travel insurance, excess baggage fees, any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip, items of personal nature, and all other items not specifically mentioned.

PAYMENT:

A full deposit of \$500 per person is required at time of registration. Credit cards are only accepted for the initial deposit. **All other remaining payments must be made in the form of a check, including final payment.** Final payment is **due no later than 100-days prior to departure.** Registrations received after 100-days prior to departure must be accompanied by full payment. Registrations received between 90-75 days prior to departure are subject to a \$300 late fee. Tour pricing is based on a minimum group size of 26 passengers to be valid. *The following supplements may apply for smaller groups:* 25-21 travelers, \$222 per person; 20-15 travelers, \$416 per person. If group size is less than 15 travelers, the tour may be canceled due to lack of participation. **If final (full) payment is not received by Imagine Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as Imagine) 75-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$500 will be forfeited and additional fees may apply.** Imagine reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date (10/09/23) when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church. **All payments are required in US Funds.**

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While Imagine will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 75 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a **single room supplement charge of \$995 for the basic itinerary.**

ITINERARY & CHANGES:

Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, Imagine reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. **Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed, by the passenger, must be provided in writing to Imagine no later than 100-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger.** All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. **All tours are final at 70-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.**

LAND ONLY:

Land Only price is **\$4,842 per person.** Price does not include international flights. Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

AIRLINE TICKETS:

In order to keep prices low, **Imagine does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination. Imagine also does not guarantee the group will be on the same flights, particularly if registering 100 days prior to departure.** Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not Imagine. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once issued. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. Imagine is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept them as partial payment for air transportation. Deviations by the passenger, from the group's scheduled flights, could result in different routings/air carriers. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after final payment has been made, may incur additional fees.

FLIGHT TIMES:

All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. Imagine is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

PASSPORT:

Each passenger is responsible for making sure that they have a **valid passport that has an expiration date at least six months after the date of return from their trip.** A copy of your valid passport must be submitted to our office by 100 days prior to departure.

VISAS:

Applicable visas will be obtained by Imagine for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting. Imagine is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

TRIP RESCHEDULING:

Imagine and/or Trip leader reserve the right to re-schedule the dates of the Trip to future dates TBD due to governmental action, pandemic, or other circumstances beyond their control. Should that occur, all travelers will be rebooked for the new dates. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates may cancel their participation and will be assessed a cancellation fee of up to \$300 per person, plus any additional penalties/fees imposed by ground operator(s), airlines, or other vendors. Travelers can transfer to another available tour up to one year from their original departure date.

CANCELLATION FEES:

Any passenger cancelling from the day of registration to 100 days prior to departure will be charged a **\$300 non-refundable administrative fee** per person plus any airline penalties, if applicable. You will also be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room from 75 days prior until the date of departure. The following charges also apply: 99-75 days = **\$500**; 74-60 days = **\$2,750**; 59-46 days = **85% of total cost**; 45 days to day of departure = **100% of total cost. All cancellations must be received in writing. On or after the day of departure there is no refund for any services not used. We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance.** If Imagine cancels the tour due to lack of participation, there will be a charge of \$200 deducted from the amount refunded to each passenger for administrative fees plus any airline penalties if applicable. No changes may be made to the tour within 70-days of departure, as the tour is officially closed.

This represents the entire agreement between the passenger and his agent, the travel agent, the tour host, and the tour operator. Day 1 – Monday, September 9: –Depart U.S.A. for Germany

Tour members depart on our flight for Germany. After boarding our flight, we will be served meals according to airline schedules. Sit back, relax, and enjoy the on-board entertainment.

Day 2 – Tuesday, September 10: Berlin

After arriving in Berlin, we are met by our tour guide and board our motor coach to begin touring the city. Our sightseeing tour includes the city-center with the Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church, Nicolai quarter, the boulevard Unter den Linden, Checkpoint Charlie, Charlottenburg Castle, Reichstag (from outside), and Brandenburg Gate. This afternoon is at leisure to visit one of the many museums on Museum Island, such as the Pergamon, which houses an outstanding collection of Grecian and Babylonian art and architecture brought here by German archaeologists. Dinner and overnight are in Berlin.

Day 3 – Wednesday, September 11: Berlin, Wittenberg

After our bountiful German breakfast, we have a short drive through the German countryside to Wittenberg, which was the main workplace of Martin Luther from 1508. We visit Luther Hall, the Augustinian monastery where Luther lived as a monk then again in 1525 as owner with his wife and family. Luther Hall is the largest museum of Reformation history in the world. We visit the Market Square and Town Hall. Then we tour All Saints Church, the famous site where Luther posted his 95 Theses on the Castle Church door, sparking the beginning of the Reformation. It is here that Luther is buried alongside his fellow reformer, Philipp Melancthon. We tour St. Mary's Church, where Luther did the majority of his preaching. This afternoon, we attend an organ concert at the City Church. Dinner and overnight are in Wittenberg.

Day 4 – Thursday, September 12: Eisleben, Leipzig

After breakfast, we drive to Eisleben and tour the house where Luther was born in 1483 and the house where he died in 1546. We then continue to the Church of St. Peter and St. Paul where Luther was baptized. Afterwards, we go to St. Andrew's Church, where Luther preached his last four sermons and where his body was laid in state. We now enjoy a scenic drive to visit the majestic city of Leipzig. We visit St. Nicholas Church, the home of the faithful "Pray for Peace" Christians and the powerful force that transformed Germany's East and West. We visit the magnificent St. Thomas Church where Luther preached and Johann Sebastian Bach performed and directed the famous St. Thomas Boys Choir. It was here that Schiller wrote his immortal "Ode to Joy," later to be adopted

as the principal theme of "Beethoven's 9th Symphony" (which was also written in Leipzig). At the end of the day we experience the St. Thomas Boy Choir during a small concert at St. Thomas Church. Dinner and overnight are in Leipzig.



Day 5 – Friday, September 13: Dresden, Erfurt

A two-hour drive brings us to the capital of Sachsen (a state of Germany). Dresden is situated on the banks of the river Elbe. During our city tour by bus and on foot we see Zwinger Palace, the protestant Church of our Lady, the catholic Court Church, Semper opera building, Bruehlscheteraces, Residence castle, and Pillnitz castle. In the afternoon, we continue on to Erfurt, the spiritual home of Martin Luther. It was here that Luther obtained a bachelor's degree in 1502 and a master's in 1505. He also took the decisive step here to turn to theology and the monastic life, when he was caught in a violent thunderstorm nearby and took a vow to become a monk. Our walking tour begins in the historical section of the city, including St. Mary's Cathedral, where Luther was ordained as a priest. We also visit the Augustinian Monastery, with a permanent exhibit depicting Luther's life as a monk. Then we continue to visit the Church of St. Severus. Dinner and overnight are in Erfurt.

Day 6 – Saturday, September 14: Weimar, Eisenach

After breakfast, we come to the city of Weimar. We explore the city of Goethe and Schiller with a short city tour. Then we drive to nearby Eisenach and we enjoy a city tour, including a visit to the Luther House where Luther lived during his scholarship and the Bach House. Housed at this museum is an extensive collection of instruments from the 16th to 19th century and a permanent exhibition on the life and work of J.S. Bach. Here we enjoy a musical performance on historical instruments. We stay in Erfurt for overnight and dinner.

Day 7 – Sunday, September 15: Wartburg, Mainz, Ruedesheim

We start the day with touring the magnificent Wartburg Castle where Luther, disguised as "Junker Jörg" (the Knight George), translated the New Testament into German. Then a drive from the east of Germany to the west brings us to the river Rhine and to the city of Mainz, the birthplace of printing, and we visit the Gutenberg Museum where the evolution of printing is documented. Here Gutenberg's first Bible and the world's tiniest Bible are on display. Johannes Gutenberg is considered to be the most important individual-contributor of the Second Millennium. Of course we also tour the city core and learn about St. Martin's Cathedral. Next, we continue to the charming wine village of Ruedesheim, which dates back to before the Roman era. Our tour includes its history in wine-making and a wine-tasting in combination with our dinner. Overnight stay is in Ruedesheim.

Day 8 – Monday, September 16: Rhine River Cruise, Heidelberg, Strasbourg

After breakfast, we meet our boat for a cruise on the Rhine River, one of the most picturesque stretches of this majestic waterway. We'll sail past magnificent castles and the famous Loreley rock. Next, we visit Heidelberg, a gorgeous town on the Neckar River where romanticism is both past and present. Our walking tour includes the Old Town, the famous Stone Bridge over the Neckar River, the Heidelberg Castle (where the Heidelberg Confession was written in 1653), the Castle Church, German Apothecary Museum, and the Church of the Holy Ghost. Next, we cross the border of France and we come to the city of Strasbourg. We have dinner and overnight in Strasbourg.



Day 9 – Tuesday, September 17: Strasbourg, Colmar, Rhine Falls

After breakfast, we start for a city tour of Strasbourg, known as one of Europe's most beautiful cities and home

of the European Union's Parliament. We tour the Cathedral of Strasbourg, featuring carvings as delicate as lacework. We stop in the historic La Petite Strasbourg, a riverfront neighborhood that appears to be straight out of a fairytale book. Afterwards, we head for Colmar another very nice and famous city in Alsace. The frame houses of this city a worthwhile a visit. Our day continues to be filled with breathtaking sights as we cross over the borders back to Germany and then to Switzerland and visit the spectacular natural beauty at Rhine Falls, Europe's largest waterfall. Dinner and overnight are in the Constance area.



Day 10 – Wednesday, September 18: Bavarian Castles and Churches, Munich

Today, we drive around Lake Bodensee, and through the Bavarian Alps. We stop for a visit to spectacular Neuschwanstein Castle, the famous fairytale castle of King Ludwig. This fantastic castle was the inspiration for Walt Disney's castles. Next, we visit Wieskirche one of Germany's most famous churches from the baroque period. We continue to Munich for dinner and overnight.

Day 11 – Tuesday, September 19: Munich

Today, we visit Munich, the fun-filled capital of Bavaria. Our sightseeing tour highlights the Old Pinakothek Museum, Olympic Park, Deutsches Museum, Nymphenburg Palace, the Town Hall and its famous Glockenspiel. We have free time in the afternoon to stroll through the Marienplatz with its numerous shops or visit the fresh produce and flower markets. You could also visit the world famous Hofbrauhaus, complete with authentic Bavarian food and entertainment. This evening we gather for our Farewell Dinner and our final overnight in Munich.

Day 12 – Wednesday, September 20: Depart for U.S.A.

We transfer to the Munich Airport this morning for our flight to the U.S.A. We arrive home the same day.
